

## 15 MLL Vessels Receive Devlin Awards

On June 2, Chamber of Shipping (CSA) of America hosted it's annual Devlin Safety Awards luncheon. This award allows U.S. maritime industry to publicly recognize those responsible for safe ship operations. More than 180 people, representing over 70 companies attended the annual industry-sponsored event. CSA announced the results of the 2010 Jones F. Devlin Awards for vessels that have operated for at least two years without a seafarer involved in a lost-time injury.

Four mariners attended the luncheon to receive the awards on behalf of Maersk Line, Limited. Captain David Barnett, Captain John Coleman, Captain Kent Howell and Captain Scott Pendleton were honored for their commitment to safety. MLL's "Drive-to-Zero" initiative, an ambitious goal of having zero work related injuries is achievable because of the men and women of the Merchant Marine and their continual effort to provide for safety practices in ship operations, a safe working environment, and establish safeguards against all identified risks. They implement safe practices and adhere to safety procedures on a daily basis, making MLL's ships a safe place to work.
